It is likely that any volunteers will need to complete the Diocesan Safeguarding procedures **BEFORE** they begin to undertake the role and this takes some time. This applies to the recruitment of Eucharistic Ministers.

Gift Aid envelopes for the new financial year are now available in the porch. This year we expect to receive refunds of over £5000 from your contributions.
